Request: Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2000

I am formally responding, on behalf of Liverpool John Moores University (LJMU), to your request received by email on 19 April 2016, for a disclosure of information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested:

“Please provide the annual salary for the post of Director of your university, since the year 2000 until the present day. By "Director", I mean the most senior member of staff at your institution responsible of the governance of the institution, sometimes called "Vice Chancellor" or "President".

If there are additional payments that the post attracts, such as relocation allowances, please include these.”

Under Section 21 of the Act, the University is not required to provide information in response to a request if it is already reasonably accessible to you. The information you have requested is available within the Financial Statements. The Financial Statements from 2011 to 2015 are available on the University's website which can be found at <https://www.ljmu.ac.uk/about-us/public-information/financial-information/financial-statements>

Please find attached a copy of the Financial Statements from 2000 through to 2010.
