Thank you for your request for information which was received on 21 June 2021 and considered under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You requested:

I would like to enquire as to (1) how many dwellings that have received an A3, B1 or B2 rating were purchased under the Help to Buy scheme and subsequently attempted to wholly or partially redeem the equity loan, and

(2) how many of those redemptions were successful and how many denied. Timeframe: since the EWS1 form was originally introduced until today's date.
