

Must do actions

A People and Plant Co-ordination Plan should be produced where people and plant will be working together. It will include methods of communication between plant and equipment operators and pedestrian site staff.

! Important - If it is decided that a plan is not required, the rationale for this decision must be documented. i.e. relevant controls already detailed within a maintenance schedule.
