



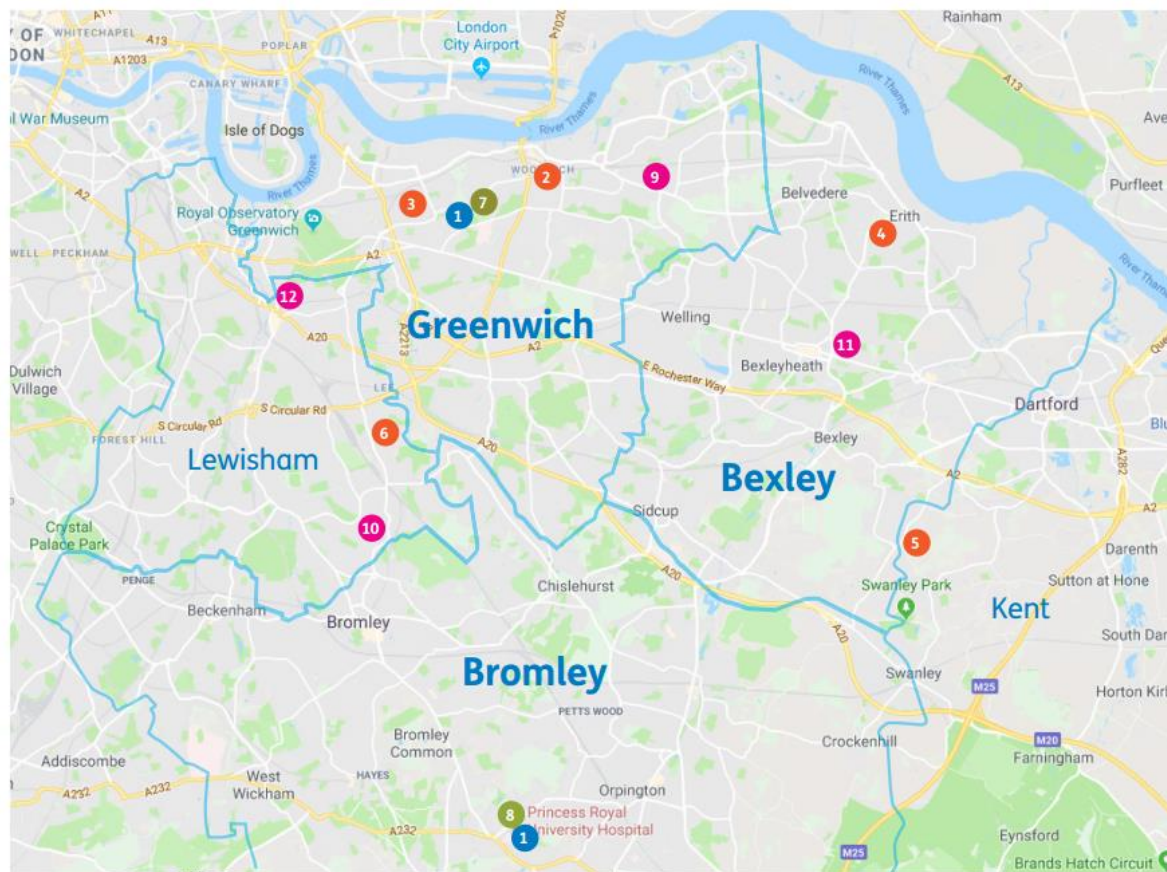

Rationale for choosing your first HI team location



If your first team is already live. then what was the rationale?

- Greenwich has the profile of an inner London Borough, and as such presented with more complex issues than Bromley and Bexley
- Positive relationships between the Police and Oxleas within Greenwich
- Preliminary discussions at High Risk Panel and between Oxleas and MPS identified suitable service users for SIM
- Greenwich had already committed to a MH Police Officer, which has now become the SIM officer, funded from MPS
- The East CMHT Locality was selected for the SIM officer base due to the high density population of Woolwich falling within this geographical area.
- Data from the 136 suite for 2016-17 identified a cohort of patients with EUPD who did not go on to be Sectioned following a 136
