**Notice pursuant to S56(1) of Highways Act 1990: Byway Open to All Traffic no.17 (known as 'Bamford Clough'), Bamford parish**

Please take this letter as a formal Notice hereby served on DCC under S56(1) of the Highways Act 1990.

On 26 September 2013, DCC made an Order, closing the Byway Open to All Traffic known as Bamford Clough to all users "to facilitate public safety due to exposed cables"; this Order has been renewed several times since and remains in force today, with no projected end-date being evident. The Byway has thus now been closed for 42 months.

Consequent upon a resolution passed by Bamford with Thornhill Parish Council at its 7 March 2017 meeting, this Council, under S56(1) of the Highways Act 1990, hereby requires DCC, in its capacity as highway authority, to state whether it admits (a) that Byway Open to All Traffic no.17 is a highway and (b) that DCC is liable to maintain it.

Please reply in accordance with the timescales laid down in S56 of the Act.
