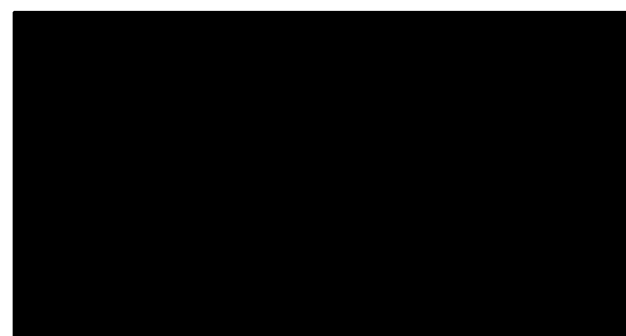
[REDACTED] has become aware that Voluntary Restraint signs have been erected on Minninglow and Gallowlow lanes. The signs depict motorcycles and [REDACTED] considers that these are likely to unnecessarily deter its members from their sustainable use of the road with motorcycles.

[REDACTED] understands that the signs have been erected as a result of [REDACTED] actions, and wishes to clarify that [REDACTED] is not represented by [REDACTED] or otherwise endorses their activities/organisation.

[REDACTED] requests the Council to secure the removal of the Voluntary Restraint signs, or otherwise to provide reasons for not doing so. [REDACTED] does not object to Voluntary Restraint signs that do not affect motorcycles.

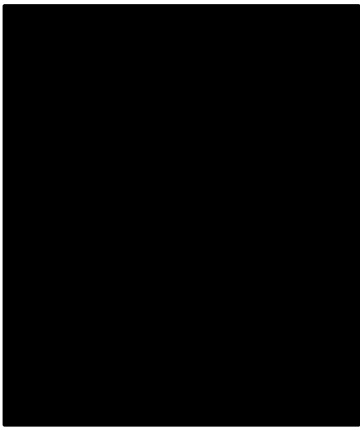
[REDACTED] respectfully requests the Council to liaise with [REDACTED] before agreeing Voluntary Restraint schemes with [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] are supportive of the Council exercising its powers to impose a temporary TRO on Minninglow Lane to restrict its use by 4x4's. This will reduce ongoing damage to the road and make a repair cheaper. [REDACTED] are willing to contribute towards both a temp TRO and a repair on the understanding that the Council would consider making a subsequent permanent TRO that places a proportionate degree of restriction on 4x4's, so as to protect the [REDACTED] investment.
