FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

Thank you for your request for documents drawn up or revised in 2006-7 relating to HM Government's plans should the monarch withhold his or her assent to a government bill or to any other parliamentary bill. The Cabinet Office received your request on 5 August 2009 and I have dealt with it under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
