Thank you for your request for information which was received by Manchester City Council on 08 October 2018 and has been considered under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You asked:

I am requesting the most recent stats for the amount of homeless women in the Manchester area.

In response to your request, please see below.

The most recent complete data we have is for the second quarter of 2018/19 - 1st July 2018 to 30th September 2018. During this period we confirmed that the following number of women were homeless after making a homeless application in Manchester:

155 single women.

385 women in other household groups. This figure will include family groups (households including dependant children) where a woman was the main applicant and also groups where an adult woman formed part of the household.

60 Women were sleeping rough during this period.

This equates to 600 adult women in total.
