Dear Mr Tsigarides

Thank you for your further e-mail of 6 October in response to the letter from my colleague, Mandy Powell, of the same day

The contents of your correspondence have been noted. This response is to inform you that if you use or keep a motor vehicle in the United Kingdom you are obliged to comply with United Kingdom statute law.

I will not engage in any discussion on this matter but confine myself to saying that any breach by you of your obligations in statute law will be dealt with in exactly the same way as any other person resident in the United Kingdom. Among other obligations you must register and licence with DVLA any vehicle kept by you and comply with the vehicle licensing requirements. Similarly you must apply for and keep up to date a driving licence issued by this agency if you intend to drive a motor vehicle on the public road. There are penalties provided for in statute law for breach of these obligations.

I trust this explains matters for you.
