Please find the Trust's response below

1. The HR/ Payroll systems – contracts are held by the DoH not by local trusts
2. Runs out 31st march 2016 but then automatically rolls over for another year – as its with our current bank (RBS).
3. Services not tendered as its part of the government banking service and they tender for this – we just use their services
4. We are not joined with another Trust
