Your email dated 13 August 2018 is considered to be a request for information under the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 2000. You requested the following information:

*I have just purchased a Original 1950/1951 Ferguson TE-20 tractor.
Me and my dad believe it is ex Military because underneath all the grey paint is green.
We went to an army show at the end of July and there were two ex military fergies. We
asked about what to look for and any signs. Everything he said added up on ours
except for one thing, a Military plate on the side. I have not looked properly here yet
as the holes may have been covered over in paint. the serial number we believe is
'149078'. it does not have a registration plate on it. can you help please?*

A search across the Ministry of Defence (MOD) has now been completed, and I can confirm that the department holds information relevant to your request. There is one vehicle showing on our records with the serial number 149078, details of which are attached.
