Deirdre and I met with the Chair and Vice Chair of the UKHCDO Executive Committee (which as I'm sure you know is the UK Haemophilia Centre Doctor's Organisation) on Friday 3 August.

We have agreed to reconsider the nature of our approach to the Haemophilia Centres because it may be better co-ordinated through, or with UKHCDO and/or the relevant Trusts/Boards.

UKHCDO holds the national Haemophilia database (located in Manchester). 




