On behalf of the Council of the London Borough of Waltham Forest, and in accordance with the usual consultation procedures on traffic and parking schemes, I wish to draw your attention to the Council's <u>intention</u> to implement the above *experimental* traffic scheme and associated Orders for your consideration and comment before making of the Orders.

I attach, for your information, a copy of the public *draft* experimental Notice of Making (EXPNoM), Statement of Reasons (SoR) and draft Traffic Orders and associated drawings.

The general effect of the experimental Orders will be to introduce three modal filters (closure to motor vehicular traffic except for cycles) and in the case of South Access Road E17 – no access except local buses - within the Quietway 2 - Argall Ave - South Access Road and Coppermill regions E17 – all with associated waiting restrictions and parking place amendments.
