1. The public rights of way over the land situate at Bill Quay, and shown by continuous bold lines on the map attached to this order shall be extinguished after 7 days from the date of confirmation of this order.

SCHEDULE

Footpath Felling 14

From Point A on the order map grid reference NZ29666275 approximately 40 metres east of Joel Terrace and approximately 65 metres north of Brack Terrace, Footpath Felling 14 then proceeds in a north easterly direction before turning north to its junction with Footpath Felling 16 at Point B on the order map grid reference NZ29776296, for a distance of approximately 250 metres, with an undefined width throughout.

Footpath Felling 15

From Point B on the order map grid reference NZ29776296 from its junction with Footpath Felling 16, Footpath Felling 15 proceeds in a south easterly direction for approximately 98 metres to its junction with the tarmac path, which runs to the rear of Marion Drive at Point C on the order map grid reference NZ29856290, with an undefined width throughout.


