DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2016**

This Order is made by Carmarthenshire County Council of County Hall, Carmarthen ("The Authority") under Section 53 (2) (b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that Authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Carmarthenshire requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53 (3) (a) (i), namely the coming into operation on the 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2016 of an Order made by the Petty Sessional Division of Carmarthenshire under Section 116 of the Highways Act 1980 for Byway Open to all Traffic 57/42 at Bryndias Farm, Pinged.

The Carmarthenshire County Council hereby order that:-

1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2016.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Carmarthenshire shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is made and may be cited as the "Carmarthenshire County Council (Byway Open to all Traffic 57/42 Bryndias Farm, Pinged) Definitive Map Modification Order 2016".

## **SCHEDULE**

### **PART I**

#### **DESCRIPTION OF PATH OR WAY TO BE DELETED**

Delete part of the highway classified as a Byway Open to all Traffic 57/42 at Bryndias Farm, Pinged as indicated from (Point 'A' on the Order Map), heading south westwards along a surfaced track and through a field gate (Point 'B'), before turning north westerly into a wider gravelled yard area where it passes in front of a house (Point 'C') before heading westerly, passing through a second field gate (Point 'D') and then continues in a north westerly direction along a defined track to terminate at a point approximately Thirty Five (35) metres west of the house (being Point 'E' on the Order Map).

Length - 80 metres

Width - A to B - 3 metres

B to D - undefined

D to E - 3 metres

#### **DESCRIPTION OF PATH OR WAY TO BE ADDED**

Add a section of Byway Open to all Traffic commencing from (Point 'A' on the Order Map), travelling south westerly along a surfaced track with a grass verge, following closely the perimeter of the farm yard to (Point 'F') where it gradually turns north west to continue to a surfaced passing place between (Point 'F') and (Point 'G'). From here, the route continues north westerly with a narrowed width for a short distance, before widening again (Point 'H') as it continues to head north westerly to re-join the original route (being Point 'E' on the Order Map).

Length - 91 metres

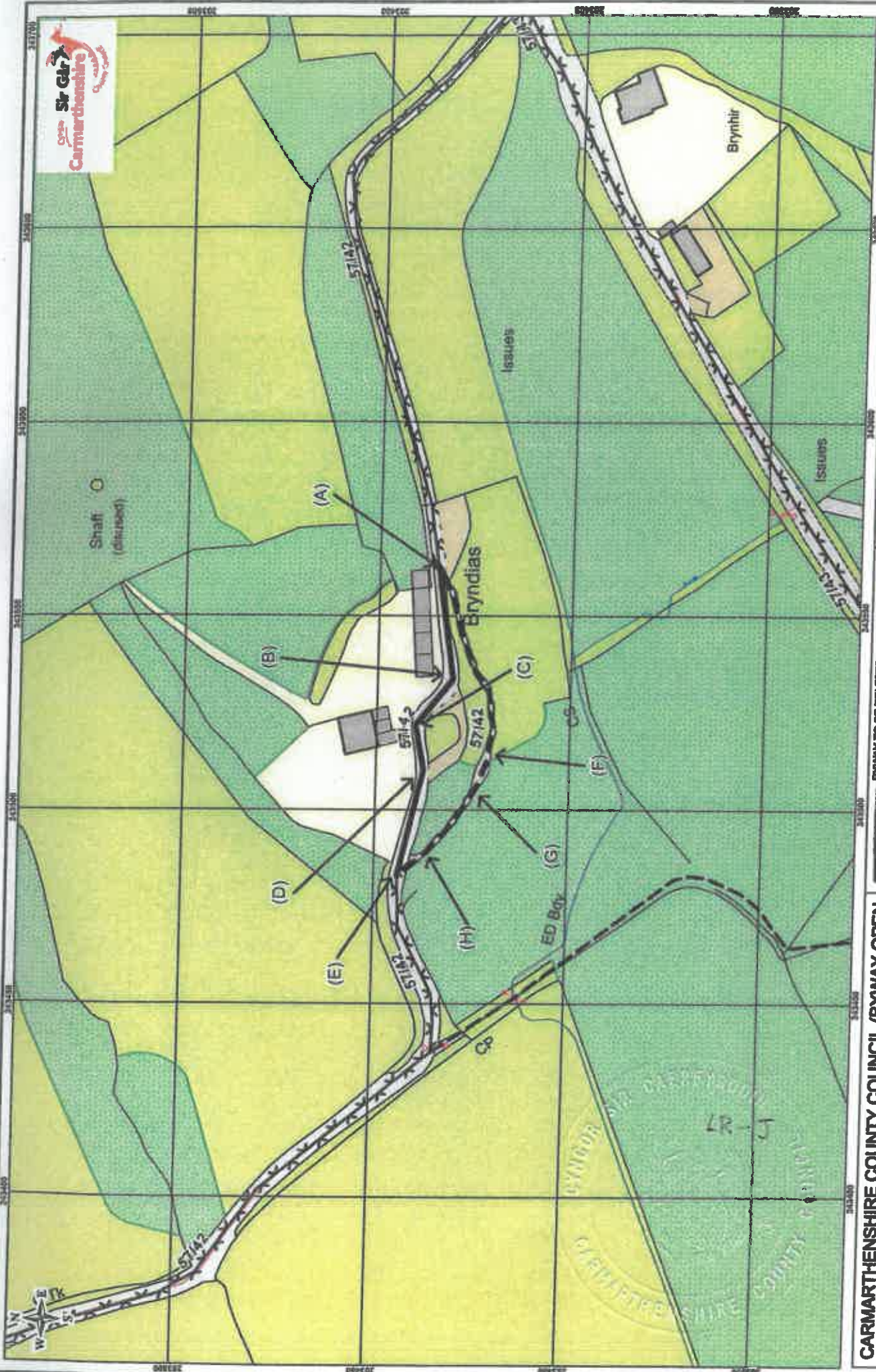
Width - A to F - 4 metres

F to G - 4.6 metres

G to H - 3 metres

H to E - 4 metres

**MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE STATEMENT**  
**VARIATION OF PARTICULARS OF PATH OR WAY**

Modify the Definitive Statement as follows:

**"Byway Open to all Traffic 57/42** - From unclassified road west of Caedu Uchaf travelling in a westerly direction along a tarmac road before turning north west onto the gravel access track leading to Bryndias Farm and following the track north west then west to Bryndias. East of the farm yard the track forks, here the Byway follows the lower southern route and continues on a defined gravel track passing south and then west of Bryndias Farm yard. It then turns in a westerly direction for a short distance before turning north west and following the final stretch of gravel track before re-joining a tarmac roadway and proceeding in a generally westerly direction to meet the B4317 county road adjacent to Ty Ysgol (SN 440034 to 427037)".
