Once a permit application is received we undertake an initial assessment to ensure we have a complete application. Following this, it is considered 'duly made'.

Sites such as Intensive Poultry units are considered High Public Interest and are advertised on the Environment Agency website at: Environmental permitting: waste, installations and radioactive substances activity notices of applications made - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk). I note that there are several live applications in Herefordshire.

I emailed our permitting service yesterday about the turkey to broiler applications as there are considerable delays with our determination process (due to staff turnover rates etc) and will check that they will also be covered by the same adverting process (I believe that this will be a variation, rather than a new permit).

We hear rumours three turkey farms in the county are applying for permits to convert to chicken farms.

I don't know if there is any information you are able to share – planning apps are public.

We presume if in the catchment they would be subject to an HRA as a new project in the SAC/SSSI and NE would be a consultee.

For us, once known we can check back on the planning approval as to whether it is Turkey or poultry that was approved.

We would want to look at odour modelling impacts, traffic impacts etc.
