I am sorry for the inconvenience here but is there anything I can help with specifically in regard to this in an alternative way?

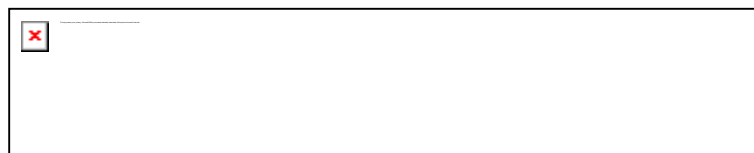
