Two years ago, the Prime Minister pledged to reform the Gender Recognition Act in England and Wales so that trans people could gain legal recognition of their gender without a demeaning, lengthy and expensive process.

Last year, tens of thousands of us responded to the UK Government's consultation on improving the law. Together we have made a strong case for reform.

Now, as the UK Government moves forward with the reforms, they need to know they can count on the support of MPs to pass the law in Parliament. That's where you come in.
