

My colleague passed on your name as SDS' contact at Stonewall. I work within the Apprenticeship Equality Team and we are looking to run some events in March to share good practice in diversity and inclusion with our contracted training providers who deliver the apprenticeship programme. We would like expert organisations to run workshops on different topics and wondered if Stonewall would be able to deliver a workshop on LGB inclusion – perhaps promoting the Stonewall guides on inclusive workplaces.


