Produced as a collaboration between the Local Government Association, Stonewall, the Sex Education Forum and seven local authorities, ‘*Engaging with schools and communities to support inclusive teaching of RSE*’ showcases practice from across the country. It features case studies from five of our CYPs Champions – Brighton & Hove, Camden, Leeds, Leicestershire and Northumberland – and can be [downloaded from the LGA website](#).
