The campus is located in the picturesque village of Wye within the North Downs area of outstanding natural beauty.



### History

The historic buildings of the North Campus, standing in the heart of the village, create an excellent atmosphere reminiscent of an Oxford or Cambridge college.


The Old Hall and Latin School date from 1447. By contrast, the award winning Kempe Centre, purpose built in 1997 as an IT hub and library, houses a high speed broadband link for educational activities. The laboratories were recently used for molecular biology research in plant science.



#### Location

Wye's location gives it several unique advantages. It is in the heart of the most glorious countryside in the Garden of England and yet less than an hour from London's St Pancras station by the UK's only high speed commuter train service. This makes it accessible to Leeds, Sheffield, York and Manchester in less than four hours.







#### **Environment**

Wye is in a nationally designated Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, sitting in the lee of Wye Downs National Nature Reserve. The chalk scarp above the Campus rises 700 feet above sea level. The Downs are one of the most biologically diverse habitats in the country.







### **Community**

Wye is an attractive and thriving village with many active groups, including the flourishing Arts Society and Business Association. It is self-sufficient with a health centre and local shops, and runs a farmers' market on the first and third Saturday of each month. There are two excellent primary schools, and secondary schools nearby in Ashford and Canterbury. The local Stour Music Festival celebrates its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2012. All this makes the village a very attractive community to join.

The Wye Campus site should therefore be of great interest to schools, businesses, educational establishments and professional associations, who are seeking to realise their assets or to escape the increasingly high rents in London, and to offer their employees the quality of life that enables them to attract the right talent.
