We have calculated the distances by mapping the routes on our 'Map Gwynedd' programme and there are some minor variations to your data.

** Please note that this route, although the shortest distance, is not the quickest. Taking a route through Bala town would be a distance of 6.3miles but along larger roads and would appear faster.*

In the same email the local authority also confirmed that it was content with the following statement:

The local authority has indicated that depending on the number of children who transfer from Ysgol y Parc there will be an adequate school budget to cater for 3 to 4 teachers at Ysgol O.M Edwards.
