Accompanying notes:

- Data may include applicants that applied/deferred in a previous cycle.

- % Offer Holders taking 'A-level' and 'Further Mathematics' is based on applicants with the following criteria:
 - All application categories included (Home/Overseas/other).

- Indicating they were taking an ‘A-level’ (or variations of) in the subject title ‘Further Mathematics’ (or variations of) in the relevant section of the UCAS application form.
- Were made a conditional or unconditional offer. Applicants who accepted, declined and/or did not respond were included.
