[REDACTED]. I have attached some photographs for you. As far as I can see they have stuck to the plans provided. There was always a lot of trees going to be removed from this site. Protective fencing for the ones remaining appears to be in place. The 3 trees retained on the west side of the site for the breeding birds do seem quite exposed but this is what the ecologist recommended.

I was surprised about the pipe work on the south side of the site. It does mean that about half of this flat area has been fenced off and access to this from Clive Road is blocked. I spoke to one lady from Clive road who was walking her dog who also seemed surprised so I don't know if there were signs up or anything prior to this happening. I certainly think a sign to advise on the duration of this should be provided.

I didn't get full access on to the site but it is quite open. The only area I wasn't really able to see were the retained trees in the far north western corner.
