

## **Summary of meetings and communications with Billingham Church of England School Council**

8 Members and teacher present at meeting

Existing play equipment

1. Most of the school council did not know where the play equipment was in the village
2. Those that did know stated that they –
  - a. Did not go there as the equipment old fashioned and was mucky
  - b. Did not go there because it was too far from home and out of the way

Proposed play equipment (iPlay)

1. All thought it would be good to have because –
  - a. It was a good game which you can play with others
  - b. It would help us to get fit while having a good time
  - c. It could be used by smaller children
  - d. It could be used by those disabled
  - e. It could be used as part of school PE lessons if located beside the school
2. The equipment should be located next to the Children's Centre on part of the old Lafford School site, now derelict.
3. It should be available outside of school times

4. At each class almost all of the children were in favour of the new equipment and would be really happy that it comes to us.
