All the above contributions (with the exception of the final payment from the Lowsley Farm development) are currently being held by the County Council and have not been allocated to any projects at this point.

The need to expand Liphook Infant and Junior Schools is kept under constant review and the expansion will be undertaken should the need arise. No funding has been sought for pre school/nursery places or apprenticeship and training opportunities for 16-18 year olds.
