## TRANSPORT AND WORKS ACT 192: APPLICATION FOR THE PROPOSED CROSSRAIL (KENSAL GREEN) ORDER

I am writing to advise you of the need for an Inspector to be appointed to conduct an inquiry into this proposed application.

The application is for the Crossrail (Kensal Green) Order and is being promoted by Crossrail Limited. The application would confer powers on Crossrail to take temporary possession of land at the site of a former gas works at Kensal Green in the Royal Borough of Kensington & Chelsea for the provision of a work site in order to support works authorised by the Crossrail Act 2008, and access for construction. The Order would authorise the temporary possession of the land for the purposes of the works and would confer powers in connection with the carrying out of the works.

The application received 5 objections of which all are statutory. One of those objectors has exercised their right to have their objection heard before a public inquiry. The main issues raised by objectors are in relation to damage to statutory utility apparatus and the loss of vehicular access to business because of the temporary closure of Canal Way.

We announced our intention to hold an inquiry on Tuesday 15 May. I am enclosing for your information a copy of the announcement letter, two copies of the published draft Order, explanatory memorandum and non technical summary of the environmental statement. We will of course send a full set of application documents and copies of the objections when the Inspector has been appointed.

I understand that you have now received from xxxxx at Eversheds LLP (the Parliamentary Agents for Crossrail Limited) their proposals for the start date of the inquiry and the venue. I would therefore be grateful if you could now proceed to appoint an Inspector please.
