Q7. What computer software are you using for Parks and Open Spaces,

Cheshire East Council commissioned Ansa Environmental Services to procure a Parks & Open Spaces Monitoring Software. Ansa are utilising the services of PSSLive (Public Sector Software) to monitor the Parks and Open Spaces of Cheshire East.

how much are you paying per year, Cheshire East initially paid £23,442 to Ansa in 2016 for a 3 year contract monitoring Play Area's, Parks and Open Spaces.

Cheshire East then confirmed an order for £23,883.90 to Ansa in 2018 for a 3 year contract monitoring Tree's across Cheshire East, including football pitch inspections.

and when is the contract due to expire The Play Area contract to Ansa shall expire in 2019, the Tree's contract to Ansa shall expire in 2021.

and what format will the procurement process take? Who within the council is responsible for this contract? Cheshire East shall review the software at Contract End Date, and decide whether to award Ansa with the additional opportunity to utilise Parks and Open Spaces Monitoring Software.
