Thank you for giving us an opportunity to review the response we have sent to your Freedom of Information request.

You asked: "For the period 2015-2017 inclusive, please provide the number of coroner's inquests where Homes for Haringey was an interested party/interested person".

Homes for Haringey provided the initial response to you that:

For the period 2015-2017 inclusive, Homes for Haringey has been an interested party/person in one Coroner's Inquest.

You asked for an Internal Review as you stated:

"The information you have provided is incorrect. There have been at least two inquest attendances during that period. Please could you carry out a proper search and provide a new response with accurate information."

I have reviewed this case and sought clarification from the relevant teams who may have been involved with a Coroner's Inquest for Homes for Haringey (HfH).

I can advise that there have been two cases where HFH were an interested party at a Coroner's Inquest within the time you are enquiring about. One in March 2017 and one in April 2015.
