2. Objectives and outcome targets of investment proposed

To provide mechanical cooling in Finchingfield ward office, Galleywood ward office, Finchingfield clinic room, tribunal room and the seminar room.

3. Options considered and rationale for choice of preferred option

Option 1 – Do nothing, the rooms continue to overheat. The clinic roomin Galleywood ward is already mechanically cooled. Drugs in Finchingfield ward continue to be at risk.

Option 2 – Install additional ventilation in the ward offices, meeting rooms & clinic room. However, this would compromise confidentiality in these areas and wouldn't be sufficient to meet the cooling requirements. In the clinic room this solution would lack the necessary controls to keep the temperature within acceptable limits for drug storage.

Option 3 – Install mechanical cooling in all areas via air conditioning units.

4. Description of proposed investment

5 x A/C units would be installed in each area, at high level on the wall. Condensers would be positioned external to the building in non-patient areas where possible, or within cages. New electrical supplies will be installed from the local distribution boards to the external condensers.

If there is no investment the temperature in these areas will remain high. Due to the use of these rooms they are high activity areas and often contain a large number of staff and visitors which will give a uncomfortable working area.

The clinic room will have an uncontrolled temperature which may mean drugs removed from cupboards and fridges will be stored at unsuitable temperatures whilst dispensing.
