I refer to your e-mail of 19 April which requested the following:

*"Please can you provide any Insurance Policies/ Documents / Categories that are held by Caudrilla that relate to the oil and gas exploration site at Lower Stumble , London Road, Balcombe, West Sussex. Can you also confirm if Caudrilla hold Environmental Impact Liability relating to the mentioned site above please."*

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act'), you have the right to

- know whether we hold the information you require
- be provided with that information (subject to any exemptions under the Act which may apply).

After checking our records I can confirm that DECC does not hold any documents which fall within the scope of your request.

#### Appeals procedure

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be sent to the Information Rights Unit at Department for Business, Innovation & Skills, who provide a shared FOI advice service to DECC: Information Rights Unit, Department for Business, Innovation & Skills, 1 Victoria Street, London, SW1H 0ET.
