

I've been informed today that the Crown Prosecution Service (CPS) has decided that no further criminal action will be taken against five serving and former officers, of constable to chief inspector rank, who were investigated regarding their involvement in the Kevin Nunes murder case.

It will undoubtedly come as a huge relief to them. I know it has been an extremely difficult time and that many people have been deeply affected by the lengthy investigation. The force, working closely with staff associations, will continue to offer and provide welfare support to all involved.

It's important to remember that the IPCC's investigation is ongoing. A second case file relating to superintendent ranks and above is due to be submitted soon so we won't be making any further comments at this stage.
