Freedom of Information Act 2000

I can confirm that the information requested is held by Durham County Council. I have detailed below the information that is being released to you.

You requested and Our response:

1) How many care services operate within your local authority?

A total of 247 care services were in scope for ICF funding in Durham, based on DHSC guidance on eligibility. Some providers operate more than one service - e.g. a care home and day service on same site, some adjustments were made for such circumstances

2) How many care services had opportunity to access the IPC grant?
247

3) How many care services (% or number) were able to successfully claim the full amount of the grant available to them?
239

4) How many care services (% or number) were able to successfully claim part of the grant available to them?
All services who claimed ICF, claimed the full amount

5) How many care services (% or number) were unable to make any claim against the grant available to them?
8 care providers did not claim the grant

Providers generally report they felt unable to spend the grant on the measures specified in the grant agreement
