Freedom of information request: Iraq Fatality Investigations

On 20 October 2018 you made the following request:

Does the Attorney General have any supervisory, compliance or administrative relationship with the Iraq Fatality Investigations (IFI) of any nature, and if so, what?

The Freedom of Information Act 2000 gives individuals and organisations the right of access to all types of recorded information held at the time the request is received, by public authorities such as the Attorney General's Office.

In response to your request I can confirm that the Inspector of the Iraq Fatality Investigations (IFI) can request undertakings from the Attorney General that witnesses will not be prosecuted on the basis of self incriminating evidence provided to the IFI.

This role of the Attorney General in providing undertakings is set out on the IFI website: <a href="https://www.gov.uk/government/collections/iraq-fatality-investigations">https://www.gov.uk/government/collections/iraq-fatality-investigations</a>. The website also contains IFI reports which contain previous undertakings given by the Attorney General.

The Attorney General has no further supervisiory, compliance or administrative role with the IFI.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the respoe to your original request. This should be addressed to the address above.

If you are not content with the outcome of the internal review, you have the right to apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision.
