Please supply a copy of the CCG's latest IT/IM & T/Digital Strategy?	Horsham & Mid Sussex CCG does not currently have an up to date digital strategy. Horsham & Mid Sussex CCG has recently formed part of a wider alliance which consists of another four CCGs. Each of the five CCGs digital strategies are being reviewed to ensure there is a single uniform strategy fit for the future.
2. Does the CCG work within a shared services agreement with surrounding Trusts or CCGs?	Horsham & Mid Sussex CCG contract's for IT services is aligned to the neighbouring six CCGs within Sussex.
3. Does the CCG outsource any of their IT Infrastructure services?	Yes, Horsham & Mid Sussex CCG outsources the majority of its IT services which includes helpdesk provision, desktop support and the full range of infrastructure services such as networks and servers.
4. Who is the CCG's current Chief Clinical Information Officer (CCIO)?	Horsham & Mid Sussex CCG does not currently have a dedicated CCIO, the clinical involvement for digital developments is provided by neighbouring CCGs within the alliance.



5. Who is the CCG's current CIO/ IT Director?	The CCG does not currently have a CIO / IT Director. The Director with responsibility for digital services is the Head of Strategic Finance Mark Baker.
6. Which member of the board is responsible for IT?	The Director with responsibility for digital services is the Head of Strategic Finance Mark Baker.
7. Please provide an organisation chart for your IM&T department?	Please see attached Organisation Chart.
8. Which member of the CCG is the SRO for the STP engagements?	The SRO for STP engagements relating to digital developments is undertaken by Tim Moore, Deputy Director of Digital.
9. What proportion of the CCG IM&T Department is made up of interim staff and permanent staff?	18 permanent and 4 fixed term appointments
10.Is the CCG looking to migrate to the cloud in the next 2 years?	Yes, it is likely Horsham & Mid Sussex CCG will migrate its services onto the Office 365 platform within 18 months.
11.Is the Trust considering their options of outsourcing their IT Services in the next 3 years?	Horsham & Mid Sussex CCG already has the majority of its IT services outsourced. This contract is due to expire on 31/10/19.
