## Freedom of Information Act Request - Case 416

Thank you for your request under the Freedom of Information Act received by us on 24 May 2013. I have repeated your enquiry and provided answers below.

- (a) Please could you tell me how many paintings or artefacts by the artist Jack Vettriano have been purchased and held in the Tate Collection
- (b) Please could you tell me how many paintings or artefacts by the artist Jack Vettiano have been donated or loaned to the Tate Collection
- (c) Whether there is a Tate Gallery Board policy document that cover an acquisition policy and process in fulfilement of the Section 2 (2) of the Museum and Gallaries Act 1992, which states:
- "So far as practicable and subject to the provisions of this Act, the Tate Gallery Board shall maintain a collection of British works of art and of documents relating to those works, and a collection of Twentieth Century and contemporary works of art and of documents relating to those works"

Question (a): I can confirm that Tate does not hold any works by Jack Vettriano in the collection.

Question (b): There is no record of any works by the artist having been loaned to Tate and no works have been donated to Tate to be held in the collection.
