Thank you for your Freedom of Information (FOI) request received on 25th October 2020. You wrote:

"Please provide me with all Jobseeker Direction guidance used by Jobcentre work coaches for Universal Credit claimants."

DWP Response

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, we have established that the information you requested is not held by this Department.

A Jobseeker's Direction is defined in the Jobseekers Act 1995 and means a direction can be given by an employment officer at any time, with the purpose of assisting the claimant to find employment, and/or improving the claimant's prospects of being employed. This provision relates to those claimants in receipt of Jobseeker's Allowance.

However, you may find the following explanation useful. We have provided this outside our obligations under the FoI Act. The Department routinely publishes Universal Credit guidance in the House of Commons Library, which was last updated on 29 October 2020, and can be accessed by members of the public online at:
