Thank you for your Internal Review request received on 15 February2018. An internal review has been carried out by someone of a senior grade to the person who dealt with your original request. I am now in a position to respond to you. In your review request you said:

You needed to request a better answer regarding our plans on whether JSA claimants will be forced to move to Universal Credit during the roll out of UC in their area

In response to your request, I can confirm that the handling of your original request and response has now been appropriately reviewed by someone unconnected with the handling of your original request.

As a result of this review I can advise that I find the original decision to be upheld. The reasoning behind this decision is as follows:

The information given was correct. We stated 'we do not currently hold information on arrangements for migration of legacy benefits onto Universal Credit'. By this we mean detailed plans continue to be developed and will be communicated in due course.
