### Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your request for information made under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000, relating to the Kent Test. Please note that we will routinely publish 2019 Kent Test results, broken down by District, within one week of Kent Test results being released, we are therefore relying on section 22 - future publication to exempt this information at this time. We do not publish results for each school due to concerns that children and/or their parents/guardians could recognise their own results and/or that of their friends. This could constitute a breach of data protection legislation and therefore the information cannot be disclosed under section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 on the grounds that it is personal information.

If you are unhappy with this response, and believe KCC has not complied with legislation, you have 40 working days from the date of this response to ask for a review.
