Thank you for your request for information made under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 relating to the Kent Test. Please see the response provided below:

I would be grateful if you would please supply the following data in an Excel for ALL the children who sat the Kent test this year (i.e. Oct 2020):

- Gender
- Kent or Other LA
- Kent Test Result
- Maths standardised score
- English standardised score
- Reasoning standardised score
- Total standardised score

KCC can confirm that we hold this information. However, this information is exempt form disclosure as it could potentially identify the individuals involved, especially if combined with other data, and this would constitute a breach of the Data Protection Act 2018. We are unable to provide this data, even in an 'anonymised' form, as individuals would be able to identify their own data in the report.

Therefore, this information is exempt from disclosure under section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 on the grounds that it is personal information. For your convenience, please see Appendix 1 for further details of this exemption.

If you are unhappy with this response, and believe KCC has not complied with legislation, you have 40 working days from the date of this response to ask for a review. Appendix 1 -
