Thanks for coming down to discuss PTP issues today; and I'm sure Reggie and Hannah pointed out our aspirations for taking some of this work forward given the need to best cater for the range of development sites coming forward in the RPS up to 2026.

However, in the shorter-term I was hoping you'd be interested in putting together a short proposal utilising your 'smart travel style' tool to determine propensity to be receptive to PTP measures. I have two large-scale transport strategy pieces of work ongoing at the moment looking at Taunton/Bridgwater and Yeovil; and this evidence would fit neatly into these pieces of work if we can get these turned around reasonably swiftly.

Ideally I'd like an assessment of each town (is the end result a PTP 'map' similar to an accession-type plot?), together with an explanation of the methodology used (and rationale), a bit of analysis - recommendations for higher priority areas etc, pulled together into a short report covering the three towns.

If you could let me know your thoughts on how you could approach this (and your interpretation of what's required), when you could complete the work, what you would do in a bit more detail, and a cost estimate (together with any other info you think relevant)?
