**RE: TRAVELLER SITE ALLOCATIONS DOCUMENT – CALL FOR SITES  
LAND TO NORTH OF OLD HOLLOW, OLD HOLLOW, COPTHORNE**

I am writing to you regarding the above site and its potential consideration for use as a permanent Gypsy and Traveller accommodation site.

National Planning Policy sets out that Local Authorities must make an assessment of the need for Traveller sites within their area, and to develop planning policies to ensure that the need is met including the identification of land for sites. For Mid Sussex, a requirement has been established for an additional 34 permanent pitches in the district for the period to 2031 (available to view at [www.midsussex.gov.uk/8686.htm](http://www.midsussex.gov.uk/8686.htm)).

In order to meet this need, Mid Sussex District Council are inviting the submission of specific plots of land that could be considered for use as permanent sites to meet the needs of local Gypsy and Traveller residents and their families.

It would be extremely useful if you could please confirm the position regarding the potential promotion of the above site, even if this is just to state that the site is not available for Gypsy and Traveller accommodation; that you no longer have any interest with the site; or have other landholdings that you wish the Council to consider.
