Release of Information

Thank you for your correspondence of 20 December 2021 in which you requested the following information:

'Dear Royal Navy, May I look at the latest edition of the JSP-950'

Your enquiry has been considered to be a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act).

Following our initial enquiries, it has become apparent that the Ministry of Defence (MOD) requires further detail from you to assist us in processing your request. Can you please confirm whether you are seeking a full copy of JSP 950 or if you are seeking a specific part? Any additional information you can provide will assist us in identifying the most relevant parts.

Under section 16 (Advice and Assistance) of the Act, the JSP 950 is a large document and contains multiple volumes. The contents of each volume are detailed in Annex A to this letter and may be of use to you in identifying what information it is that you are seeking.

Under section.1(3) of the Act, a Public Authority may refuse to respond to an FOI request where it requires further information in order to identify and locate the information requested. It will be necessary to close your enquiry under this reference number until we have received clarification as detailed above. Once the further information is received this will constitute as a new request of which there will be a new 20 working day period to respond.

If you wish to complain about the handling of your request, or the content of this response, you can request an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, Ground Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review should be made within 40 working days of the date of this response.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may raise your complaint directly to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
