Dear colleagues

I am responding on behalf of Achieving for Children to Turing House School's proposed admissions arrangements for 2020/2021. The consultation for 2020/21 refers to Sixth Form admissions only, and makes no reference to the admissions arrangements for Years 7 to 11. A school's admissions arrangements must include all year groups, and any consultation must refer to the admissions arrangements for all year groups at the school, in the year of determination, in this case 2020/21. I assume you have not consulted arrangements for Years 7 to 11 as there are no proposed changes to these arrangements for 2019/20, and if so, this needs to be explicitly stated in the consultation. Once you determine the arrangements for 2020/21, it is advisable to ensure that the determination refers to the admissions arrangements for all year groups, and states that you have not consulted arrangements for Years 7 to 11 because there are no proposed changes to the admission arrangements for 2019/20.

I hope this is helpful.

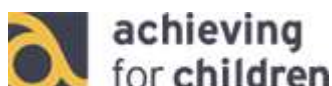
