2. How many Local Reviewers are engaged by the CCG? Of these, how many are permanent employees?	Reviewers cover the whole of Sussex including West Sussex. There are 29 active reviewers in Sussex Some are permanent CCG staff in other roles. The CCGs have one permanent employee in e LeDeR specific role who undertakes some reviews as part of their role.
3. How many LeDeR notifications did the CCG receive in 2018?	16
4. How many LeDeR notifications did the CCG receive in 2019?	15
5. How much did the CCG spend on agency or independent LeDeR reviewers in the last financial year (1/4/19 to 31/3/20)?	It is not possible to provide financial information at a CCG level, however £17,909.68 was spent in the 2019/20 financial year across Brighton and Hove and East Sussex.
