DWP Response:

Personal information about you is treated as exempt information under section 40(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). By handling your request under the provisions of the Data Protection Act 1998, DWP are protecting your rights over your own personal information.

The timescale for handling requests under the Data Protection Act is 40 calendar days from receipt, although we do aim to respond as soon as possible.
