Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your recent Freedom of Information request received on 26 May 2017. Your request was as follows:

- 1. Why and at what level of management was it decided to employ actors to role play during interviews with library staff during the most recent restructuring?
- 2. How were the actors sourced and if from a company, why was it chosen namely, how did it prove it should win the contract?
- 3. What was the total cost of all the actors hired

Response

The decision was taken by the libraries programme board, which comprises senior/executive directors responsible for the service in each of the three councils, and the director of libraries. The board considered that a robust selection process was required to ensure that all staff were given a fair opportunity to secure a role in the new structure, and that the use of interviews would be augmented by selection tests. The role play assessments which made use of actors were for managerial positions only to test their responses to "real life" situations.

The company used have provided assessment services and courses to Westminster City Council in the past and are part of the framework.

A total cost of the actors hired cannot be provided as they were included in the cost of the total package and not broken down by sections of the project.

I hope this provides the information you require.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to:
