Request for Information – RFI20170252

Thank you for your request of 3rd February 2017 under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act') seeking the following information:

*“This is a freedom of information request lodged under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 for full disclosure and publication of information about the following:
The licence fee evasion model used by the BBC Licence Fee Unit
and
How the BBC Licence Fee Unit uses the licence fee evasion model to calculate licence fee evasion rate
and
How BBC Licence Fee Unit determines the accuracy of the findings of the licence fee evasion model”*

Please note that “TV Licensing” is a trade mark used by companies contracted by the BBC to administer the collection of television licence fees and enforcement of the television licensing system. The majority of the administration of TV Licensing is contracted to Capita Business Services Ltd ('Capita'). Over-the-counter services are provided by PayPoint plc ('PayPoint') in the UK, and by the Post Office in the Isle of Man and Channel Islands. Marketing and printing services are contracted to Proximity London Ltd. Media services are contracted to Media Planning Limited trading as Havas Media UK. The BBC is a public authority in respect of its television licensing functions and retains overall responsibility.

Please be advised that detailed information relevant to your request is published in the Television Licence Fee Trust Statement for the Year Ending 31 March 2016 and, more recently, in the National Audit Office report into the collection of the Licence Fee. As these documents are already in the public domain, may I refer you to the published sources below, pursuant to section 21 of the Act (information freely available elsewhere):
