I am writing to advise you that following a search of our paper and electronic records, I have established that the information you requested is held by the Cabinet Office.

Information you have requested is exempt under section 21(1) of the Freedom of Information Act. Section 21 exempts information if this information is reasonably accessible to the applicant by other means. Section 21 is an absolute exemption and the Cabinet Office is not required to consider whether the public interest favours disclosure of this information.

I can advise that all surplus government property is advertised on Government Property Finder. The information you requested can be found here: <a href="https://www.gov.uk/find-government-property">https://www.gov.uk/find-government-property</a> and in the first instance you should identify a suitable

property/properties and contact the land-owning department to discuss the possibility of a purchase.
