Thank you for your request for information received on 4 May 2021.

### Your request

*We would like to request the locations and any data held on road blocks and modal filters installed by the Council.*

*We are requesting the geographical locations of these blocks and modal filters installed between 1970 and 2015, as well as the dates they were installed, the type of filter and the materials used (if this information is available)*

*The data we require is:*

1. Location
2. Date implemented (year or year/month)
3. Type of block or filter: allows pedestrians only, pedestrians & cyclists (modal filter), buses (bus gate), emergency services only (fire gate)
4. Information on materials if available (concrete, brick, planters etc.)

### Our response

This request is being handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I can confirm that Hammersmith & Fulham holds the information you requested. However, we are withholding that information since we consider that the following exemptions apply to it.

We consider that the absolute exemption set out in Section 21 (Information accessible by other means) applies to the information requested because the information requested is already reasonably accessible elsewhere.
